

## Grading system and ECTS Grading Table (EGT) at University West

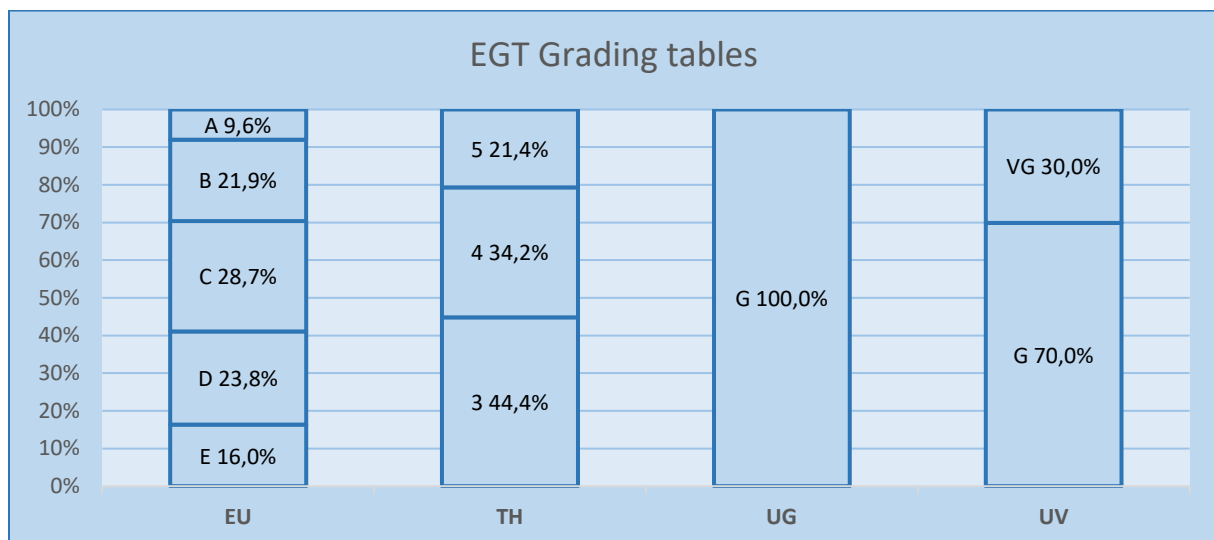
The ECTS Grading Table enables grades from different universities in different countries to be compared. Each university use its local grading system, but the EGT shows the statistical distribution these grades.

University West uses four different grading systems:

- Two grade scale – Failed or Passed grade
- Three grade scale – Failed, Passed or Passed with Credit
- Four grade scale – Failed, 3, 4 or 5 grade (5 being Passed with Credit)
- A-F grade scale – F, E, D, C, B or A (F being Fail grades and A being Passed with distinction)

Please find below a list of these grading scales in comparison to each other and percentage distribution between the levels within each.

All international transcripts includes EGT as a standard, but as the EGT is not given for courses/course codes with fewer than two years' data, the distribution table below will facilitate conversion for those grades where EGT data is currently unavailable for a completed course in the transcript issued.
